- To develop integrity, sportsmanship and cooperation.
- To develop leadership abilities, build character and assume citizenship responsibilities.

Rabbit and Cavy Care and Feed Record Book Guidelines:

It is suggested that a copy of the record book be made for use as a work copy. Records should then be transferred into this book for submission in a plastic folder with prongs and pockets.

Senior 1- Purple Folder Senior 2- Black Folder

- Your record book should start with the **purchase date of your animal OR September 1st of the current year.**
- **Your age should be listed as of September 1st of the project year.**
- Your record book should contain information relating only to your current rabbit project animals. If you have more than one project animal, you must identify which animal when completing various sections of this record book.
- Have someone check your project story for spelling and grammar before you write it in the final record book.
- **Exhibitors ages 13 and under may fill out their record books with a pencil. Ages 14 and older must be handwritten in blue or black ink.**
- Record books may have a maximum of six pages of pictures, front only. All pictures must have captions. Pictures of club meetings, community service, fund raisers, and educational field trips should be included. **No scrap booking.**
- **All pages of this record book must be printed front only on white paper.**

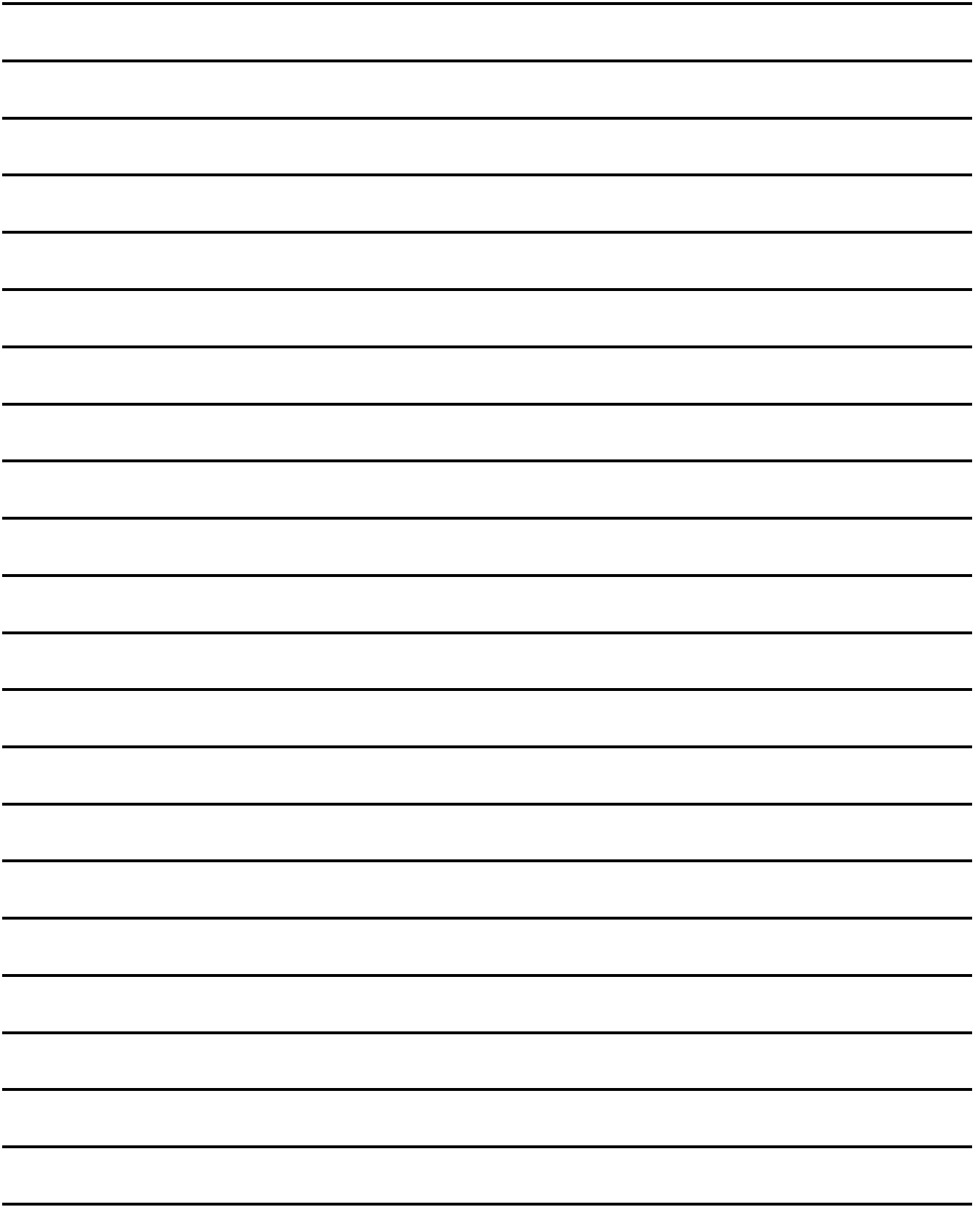

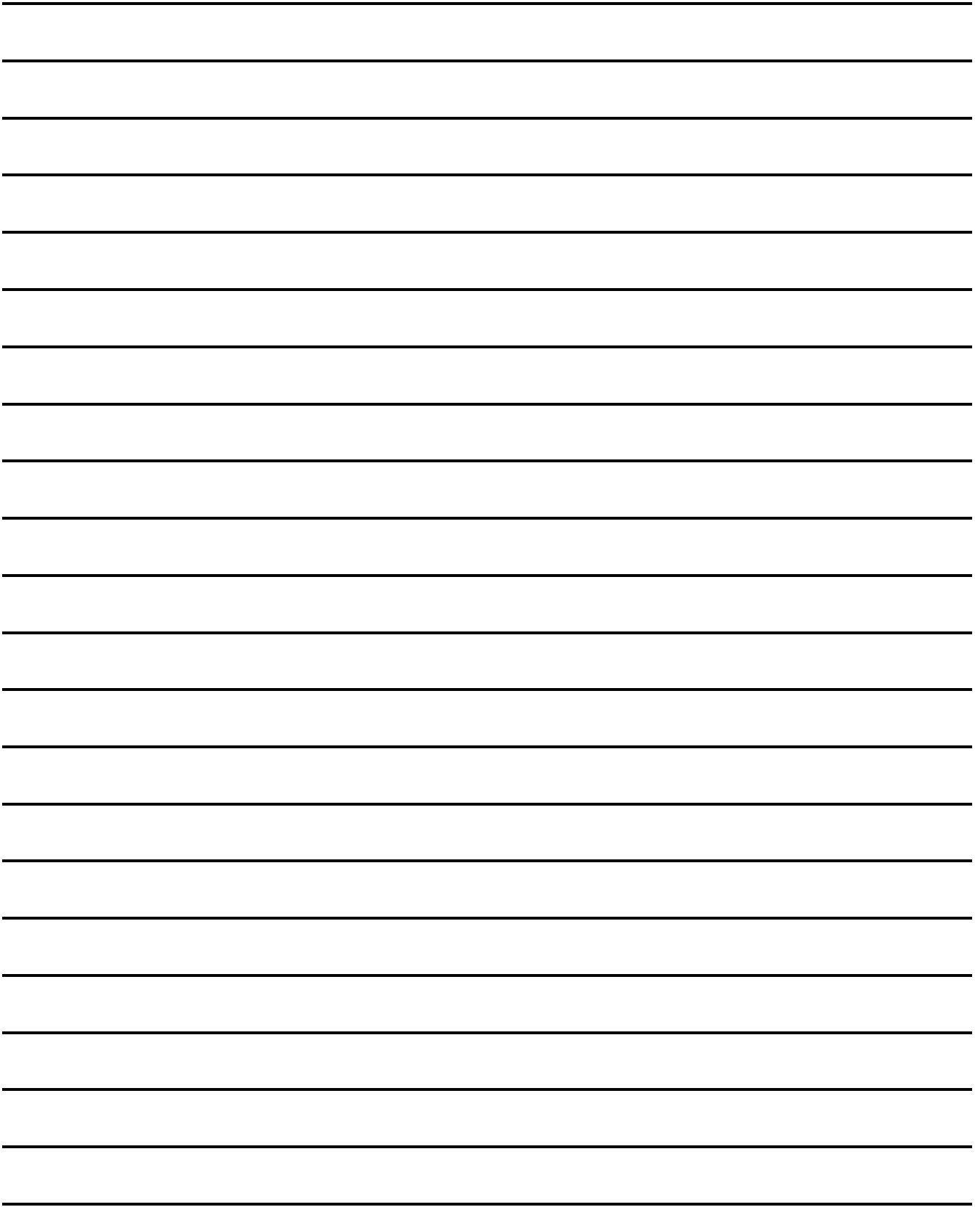
