Why: Under Chapter 487 – Florida Pesticide Law, In order to apply or supervise the application of restricted use pesticides on golf courses, parks or cemeteries, the applicator must be in the possession of a valid Ornamental & Turf license. Obtaining an Ornamental & Turf License is a two step process. First a general standards exam must be passed and then the Ornamental & Turf exam. This two session program will provide crucial information to prepare you for both the General Standards / Core and the Ornamental & Turf exams.

Directions to St. Lucie County Extension:

From Martin County

I-95 north to Exit 129 take route 70 West, turn right on Kings Highway. Take second left off King's Highway onto Picos Road. At first stop sign continue straight. The Hurricane House will be the first building on the right hand side.

From St. Lucie County

Take Okeechobee Rd (route 70) to Kings Highway; turn right onto Kings Highway and take second left off King's Highway onto Picos Road. At first stop sign continue straight. The Hurricane House will be the first building on the right hand side.

From Indian River County

I-95 south to Exit 130 (Orange Ave Extension West) Head west to Kings Highway and turn left. Take Kings Highway to Picos Road, turn right. At first stop sign continue straight. The Hurricane House will be the first building on the right hand side.
